# Researchers' Forum - World Hemp Forum 2024

## To PhD students and post-doctoral researchers,

The 1st edition of the World Hemp Forum will take place on November 19 & 20, 2024, at the Aube Congress Center in Troyes (France) a historical and major region for hemp cultivation in Europe! This event is open to all professions and markets related to hemp, encompassing a TRL continuum from academic research to industrialization and market introduction.

An international session is scheduled on November 19 from 2:30 PM to 5:00 PM featuring presentations by Lorie Hamelin (INSA Toulouse) and Stefano Amaducci (Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore, Piacenza, Italy). This session will focus on the impact of climate change on hemp cultivation, the environmental impact of this cultivation and its integration into territorial socio-technical systems.

On this occasion, an exchange forum is organized to allow PhD students and post-doctoral researchers to present their work.

#### In this context, we are launching a call for poster presentations.

- The Call for Papers is open to recent work (less than two years old) in the field of hemp research (production, valorization, and applications).
- It is open to all disciplines and subjects, even if they are not directly related to the main theme of the session.
- Posters will be displayed during the two days of the forum in the dedicated Researchers' Forum space, and all participants will have the opportunity to speak with the authors at various times throughout the event.
- Authors of the poster must register, attend in person, and display the poster during the dedicated session.

Posters provide an interactive means to present and showcase the highlights of ongoing research. It is an excellent opportunity to meet and discuss with colleagues from diverse academic, disciplinary, and geographical backgrounds, as well as industry stakeholders.

## **Submission Guidelines**

# Deadline: September 20, 2024

To submit your poster, please send a title and a summary in English (400 words) to <a href="mailto:contact@polechanvre.eu">contact@polechanvre.eu</a> by midnight on Friday, September 20, 2024, including your name, affiliation(s), any co-authors, postal and email addresses, and phone numbers.

Proposals will be reviewed by the forum's scientific committee, and responses will be given no later than Wednesday, October 9, 2024. Posters must be printed in A0 portrait format (84.1 x 118.9 cm) at your expense.

The proposed poster must be written in English and adhere to the expected scientific poster publication standards (title, introduction, objectives, materials/methods, results, conclusion, references, keywords) as well as the thematic fields of the forum.

The posters will remain on display throughout the event in the dedicated researchers' forum space. By participating in this poster exhibition, you commit to being present all day on November 19 to present your work during the dedicated session, breaks, or upon participants' requests.
